Who Should Attend?

Individuals working in the Construction industry that have health and safety responsibilities as part of their role, and who require a nationally recognised qualification to demonstrate competence.

Course Objectives

To provide a construction-specific qualification in health and safety.

Course Description

A 10 day course covering all aspects of construction health and safety, including such topics as legislation, working at height, fire, electricity, vehicles, excavations and demolition etc.

Pre-Requisites

Equivalent to an International English Language Testing System score of 6.0 or higher in IELTS tests.

Course Outcome

Open book exam (OBE). You will have 48 hours to complete and submit your answers. You do not have to complete the examination all in one go.
